10U / 12U B Team Progression

Overview - Northwest Girls Softball 10U and 12U Teams are organized into B and C divisions. These divisions are designed to promote safe and competitive play for all teams. Team assignment to division is ultimately at the discretion of the NWGS Board and the Player Advocate.

12B Division

1. The first teams added to the 12B division are returning 12B teams with a qualified P and C. If a 12B team does not have a qualified P or C, they can "designate" a player that must make 20% outs at that position for the season. If the "designated" player does not make qualified outs, the coach will not be given a team for the following season.
2. Next to fill the 12B division will be the 1st and 2nd place teams (with qualified P and C) from 12C in the previous season. Moving from 12C to 12B, the team must have BOTH a qualified P and C. These teams may choose to remain in 12C with approval of the NWGS Board.
3. The regular season 10B 1st place team (with BOTH qualified P and C) has the next opportunity to be placed in 12B.
4. The regular season 12C 3rd/4th place teams (with BOTH qualified P and C) have the next opportunity to be placed in 12B.
5. Any additional teams added to 12B will be at the discretion of the NWGS Board and Player Advocate.

10B Division

1. The first teams added to the 10B division are returning 10B teams with a qualified P and C. If a 10B team does not have a qualified P or C, they can "designate" a player that must make 20% outs at that position for the season. If the "designated" player does not make qualified outs, the coach will not be given a team for the following season. A 10B team without both qualified P and C will be disbanded.
2. Next to fill the 10B division will be the 1st and 2nd place teams (with qualified P and C) from 10C in the previous season. Moving from 10C to 10B, the team must have BOTH a qualified P and C. These teams may choose to remain in 10C with approval of the NWGS Board.
3. Any additional teams added to 10B will be at the discretion of the NWGS Board and Player Advocate. 8U teams may only move to 10B in extreme circumstances.
